

Classroom Environmental Education Box:
Wetland Wildlife Warriors

Description: The class will be exploring the consequences and effects of human behavior on a wetland ecosystem in a game-like setting. Participants will take on the roles of different organisms within a nearby wetland ecosystem beside the Great Smoky Mountains National Park. Their goal is to navigate challenges, solve issues, and ultimately contribute to the survival and well-being of the whole wetland.
